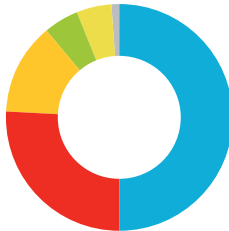

## Our School

Founded in 2003, Dulwich College Shanghai Pudong (DCSPD) is an independent international school serving 1621 expatriate English-speaking students, 287 students are in Years 10-13 (grades 9-12). There are 52 students in the Class of 2019.

Our students come from over 40 countries and range in age from 2 to 18. Up to Year 9 (Grade 8) they follow the English National Curriculum, enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10) they follow the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), a two-year course culminating in externally assessed examinations. In Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12) all our students enter and complete the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme.

English is the language of instruction.

## The Dulwich Network

DCSPD is one of ten international schools in Asia that operate in partnership with Dulwich College in London under the World Charter and together they make up Dulwich College International (DCI). Dulwich College in London inspects DCSPD and each Dulwich international school annually.

## School Calendar

The school year is 181 days, running from mid-August to mid-June. It is divided into three terms.

## Grading

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. For the duration of course work, student progress is internally assessed using pre-established, standards-based performance levels. Courses conclude with externally assessed examinations (IGCSE and IB).

## Discipline Policy

Upon request, DCSPD will report all external suspensions and withdrawals that arise as a result of a significant disciplinary incident or personal misconduct.

## Co-curricular Activities

Students are offered a rich co-curricular programme that builds on team and leadership skills. Many of our programmes are student-initiated and led. Across the College, there are dance, drama, creative arts, music, sports, robotics, academic societies, language and service groups. Service is a hallmark of Dulwich College Shanghai Pudong, and students are actively involved in the local area as well as globally.

## Academic Programmes

### IGCSE – Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10)

Students take up to 11 individual examination subjects in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course. It is common for our students to study an accelerated mathematics programme within the IGCSE. The exam is taken at the end of Year 10 and is noted on the transcript as a Year 11 mark.

All our students take Triple Award Science at IGCSE. They study physics, chemistry and biology as separate subjects and are examined in each discipline.

Grades are on a scale of A\* to G, with a letter grade of U indicating a failure to meet minimum standards.

### IB Diploma Programme - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

All DCSPD students start the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Year 12 (Grade 11). We offer 22 different IB courses, and all students enrolled in IB courses are required to sit the May exam.

## University Matriculations 2015 - 2018

We believe in helping students choose prospective colleges and universities based on "fit". For this reason, students are limited to 10 applications worldwide each academic year.
