<b>Application Fee</b>	<b>\$ 250 USD Non-Refundable</b> The Application Fee is payable once only before the testing of the student's suitability for admission.				
<b>Deposit</b>	<b>\$3,000 USD Refundable*</b> The Deposit is payable once only upon acceptance of the student, before admittance to the College. It will be refunded when the student leaves the College, less any outstanding fees or charges subject to one full term's notice (*see notice of leaving below).				
<b>Capital Levy</b>	<b>\$1,500 USD per year</b> Non-Refundable (not applicable to Toddlers; only F1 and above) If students join in Term 2, the capital levy will be an advance payment of \$1,000; or \$500 in advance if the student joins in Term 3. It is both Non-Refundable and Non-Transferable. The Capital Levy is used to cover the cost of construction and to accumulate sufficient capital funding for continuous renovation and upgrading of school equipment and facilities.				
<b>Founder's Bursary</b>	The award of the \$5,000 Founder's Bursary recognises the loyalty, commitment and pioneering spirit of our current and future parents, enabling the College to make a positive difference in our host country.				
<b>Notice of Leaving</b>	One full term's notice, in writing to the Headmaster, is required for any student leaving the College. Notice must be received by the first day of the term where the student is leaving the College at the end of that term. Where <u>less than one full term's notice</u> is provided, the deposit will be forfeited.				
<b>Refunds</b>	No refunds will be given for students leaving before the end of term, unless one full term's notice has been provided.				
<b>Invoicing</b>	All fees are payable in advance and are billed in 3 termly installments. Penalties apply where fees remain outstanding beyond the due date.				
<b>Annual Review</b>	All school fees are reviewed annually.				
<b>Termly Payment</b>	Dulwich College Yangon provides the opportunity of prepaying the fees for the full year in one lump sum, or paying both Term 2 and Term 3 fees together if joining in Term 2. However, if the parent chooses to pay these fees in installments then a 7% charge is levied. From Term 3 the 7% charge does not apply as only one payment is required.				
<b>Sibling Discount</b>	Discounts on tuition fees will be applied for siblings who are registered at DCY at the same time, as follows:  <table><tr><td><b>3rd child</b></td><td>5% for that child</td></tr><tr><td><b>4th child and subsequent children</b></td><td>10% for each such child</td></tr></table>	<b>3rd child</b>	5% for that child	<b>4th child and subsequent children</b>	10% for each such child

- School Bus Service** Dulwich College Yangon will endeavor to provide a school bus for students who require such a service. However, this may not be possible for distant locations and bus stops for fewer than three students. Please enquire for details of bus routes and charges.
- Uniform** All students must wear the Dulwich College school uniform. All uniform items are individually priced and can be purchased from the College.
- Entry other than at beginning of year** Students admitted to Dulwich College Yangon later in the academic year (including Toddlers eligible to join when they turn 2 years of age) will be charged a pro-rated fee for either a full term or half-term fees depending on admission date.
- Method of Payment** All Fees and Charges are calculated in US Dollars and are payable in US Dollars or Myanmar Kyat in advance. Payments should be made by bank transfer to the College's nominated account (see invoice for details).
- Late Payment Charge** Accounts outstanding after the due date (indicated by letter at the time of request for fee payment) will incur a late payment charge of 1.5% per month. This charge is repeated on a monthly basis whilst fees remain unpaid.
