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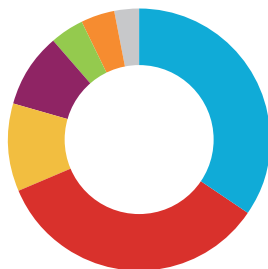

The Dulwich Network

Dulwich College (Singapore) is the seventh College to join the Dulwich family of ten international schools in Asia that make up Dulwich College International and operate in partnership with Dulwich College in London under a World Charter. Dulwich College in London inspects DCSG and each Dulwich international school annually. Close collaboration among our schools stimulation innovation and fosters an international mindset and outlook. We believe this community provides students a unique advantage for the future where creativity is celebrated and inspiration is paramount.

Our School

Dulwich College (Singapore) educates children from age 2 to 18. Our school serves 2252 students. There are 665 students in our Senior School, Years 7-13 (grades 6-12), 36 of which are in the first graduating class of 2020. The primary teaching language of DCSG is English. Up to age 5, students follow the Early Years Foundation Stage, and from Years 1 to 8, they follow the National Curriculum of England and Wales, which is enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Year 9 students embark on a three-year set of IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) courses, a rigorous course that requires students to take a broad range of subjects covering maths and sciences, English and foreign languages, and the humanities. It culminates in exams at the end of Year 11, and prepares students well for the two-year International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) starting in Year 12. Our current Year 12 students are the first to participate in the two-year IB Diploma programme. They will graduate in 2020 as our first cohort to graduate from DCSG. Many of our students study an accelerated mathematics programme within the IGCSE. The exam is taken at the end of Year 10 and is noted on the transcript as a Year 11 mark. Students then take Additional Maths which is an extremely rigorous course which culminates in an external exam which is also noted on the transcript as a Year 11 mark.

School Calendar

The school year is 181 days, running from mid-August to mid-June. It is divided into three terms.

Co-curricular Activities

Students are offered a rich co-curricular program that build on team and leadership skills. Many of our programs are student-initiated and led. Across the College, there are over 200 extracurricular activities offered to students including service to the local food bank, drama, creative arts, music, sports, robotics, academic societies, language and morning athletics. Service is a hallmark of Dulwich College Singapore, and students are actively involved in the local area as well as globally.

Grading

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. For the duration of course work, student progress is internally assessed using pre-established, standards-based performance levels. Courses conclude with externally assessed examinations.

Discipline Policy

Upon request, DCSG will report all external suspensions and withdrawals that arise as a result of a significant disciplinary incident or personal misconduct.

Academic Programmes

IGCSE - Years 9 to 11 (Grades 8 to 10)

Students take up to 11 individual examination subjects in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course. It is common for our students to study an accelerated mathematics programme within the IGCSE. The exam is taken at the end of Year 10 and is noted on the transcript as a Year 11 mark.

All our students take Triple Award Science at IGCSE. They study physics, chemistry and biology as separate subjects and are examined in each discipline.

Grades are on a scale of A* to G, with a letter grade of U indicating a failure to meet minimum standards.

All DCSG students start the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Year 12 (Grade 11) in preparation for university. Our current Year 12 students, the graduating class of 2020, is the first cohort to embark on the IB Diploma programme within DCSG.

How to Schedule a visit at Dulwich College (Singapore)

Admission representatives are welcome during student lunch breaks from 12:45 PM to 1:40 PM or during the after school extracurricular time between 3:35 PM- 5:00 PM. Arriving on Campus

Please bring your passport or ID Card with you since you will be asked to exchange an ID card for a visitor's pass at the security gate. Share with the security guard that you will be visiting the Senior School. Upon entering the Senior School lobby, please check-in with the administrative staff who will provide details about how to get to our office.

Traveling to Dulwich College (Singapore)

The College is located amongst a maturing residential town at the western region of Singapore. It takes about 40 minutes by taxi to arrive to our campus from Changi Airport. The cost of the taxi ride can be between SGD\$30-40. Tipping is not expected and is actually discouraged by the government. Feel free to arrive early, use our wifi, read the paper and relax. If you find you're running late, please call us at (+65) 6890-1000.

Arriving by:

Taxi: It takes about 40 minutes by taxi to arrive to our campus from Changi Airport. The cost of the taxi ride can be between SGD\$30-40.

Charter car: If you are on a tight schedule and plan on visiting numerous schools, this might be your best option. There are two companies [Limousine Cab](#) and [Limo Taxi](#) that allow for half, or full-day bookings that may be booked in advance online.

Bus: If you have the time, and would like to utilize the public transportation, there are a variety of bus options that will take about 2 hours.
